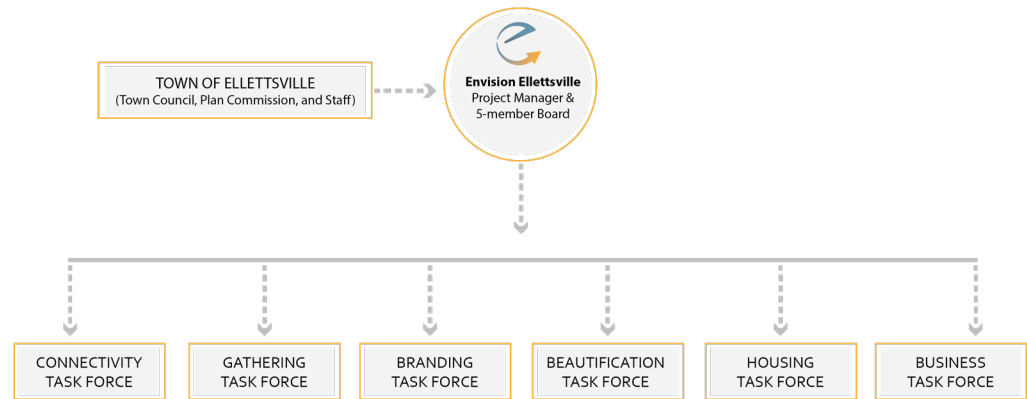

HOW WILL THE ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE BE USED?

The organization structure will be used to guide the community through the implementation of the 70+ action items outlined in the *Envision Ellettsville Vision Plan*. The organization structure defines the hierarchy of how each group will communicate and what their roles and responsibilities are in order to transform the vision into reality.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE ENVISION ELLETTSVILLE BOARD?

The Envision Ellettsville Board will guide the implementation of the *Envision Ellettsville Vision Plan* and facilitate regular communication with the general public, Town Council, and Plan Commission.

WHAT IS THE ENVISION ELLETTSVILLE BOARD RESPONSIBLE FOR?

The Envision Ellettsville Board will:

- Serve as the Vision Plan experts including communication and advocacy,
- Be the convener of people and resources,
- Serve as the Liaison between Town Officials and Task Force Groups,
- Coordinate fiscal planning including fundraising, budgeting, and grant applications, and
- Approve all grant applications before submitting.

WHO WILL SERVE ON THE BOARD?

The Envision Ellettsville Board will be made-up of five individuals from the original Envision Ellettsville Steering Committee. Representatives from the Town (Staff and/or Officials) and the consultant team do not qualify for the five board positions. These representatives will work along side the Envision Ellettsville Board.

HOW WILL THESE INDIVIDUALS BE SELECTED?

All members of the original Envision Ellettsville Steering Committee are invited to volunteer to serve on the Envision Ellettsville Board and/or the Envision Ellettsville Task Force Groups.



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WHY ARE TASK FORCE BEING CREATED?

At the end of the *Envision Ellettsville Vision Plan* Process, the Steering Committee, and community, expressed the desire to keep the momentum going by kick-starting implementation. The organizational structure strives to answer two questions, “How are we going to get things done?” and “Who needs to be involved to do it?” The task force groups provide a way for the general public and town representatives to work together in achieving a common goal.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE ENVISION ELLETTSVILLE TASK FORCE GROUPS?

The *Envision Ellettsville Vision Plan* identifies five big ideas - Connectivity, Gathering, Branding, Enhancement, and Character and Development. The task force groups will ensure each big idea is given an adequate amount of time and attention needed to move tasks forward.

WHAT ARE THE ENVISION ELLETTSVILLE TASK FORCE GROUPS RESPONSIBLE FOR?

The Envision Ellettsville task force groups will:

- Brainstorm ideas,
- Track new opportunities,
- Identify solutions for related barriers,
- Identify funding resources, and
- Communicate any progress updates with the Envision Ellettsville Board.

WHO WILL SERVE ON THE TASK FORCE GROUPS?

Each task force group will be made-up of 10-20 individuals representing the Vision Plan, Town, and general public. Each task force group will have one Envision Ellettsville Advisor (someone who has served on the original committee) and one Task Force Leader (someone who has a comprehensive understanding of the task at hand). The Task Force Leader will be selected by the Envision Ellettsville Board.

The other task force group members can be individuals that were invited to serve on the task force based on their background or members of the general public that have volunteered. The general public was invited to sign-up for a task force group at the Community Celebration in May 2022 and the Fall Festival in September 2022.

WHAT IS THE TIMELINE FOR EACH OF THE TASK FORCE GROUPS?

The task force groups will not be launched all at once. Instead, TSWDG will launch the task forces in strategic phrases based on the opportunity to moving a particular task forward. It is anticipated that the Gathering task force group will be the first to launch with Housing and Businesses following closely behind.

WHO WILL BE FACILITATING THE TASK FORCE MEETINGS?

Taylor Siefker Williams Design Group (TSWDG), in partnership with the Local Project Coordination (Kyle Hannon), will be facilitating all task force meetings.
